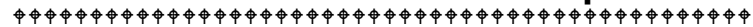
Rotational Sunday School

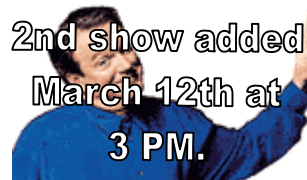

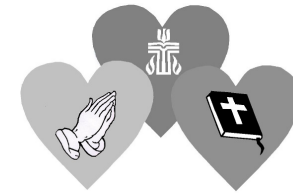
